



Environmental Policy

As a contractor we do not generally specify materials to be used or design features that will reduce waste. All specifications as to ground levels to be achieved, materials to be used and spoil or materials to be recycled or removed from site as waste are specified by our clients.

However, it remains our policy to protect the environment through attempting to influence client designs, use of sustainable resources and to use sound site practices that reduce waste generation and minimise risk to the environment.

To meet the objectives of this policy:

- ✓ We will where possible, separate waste at source; recycle on site by crushing materials etc. and attempt to reduce the amount of waste we produce.
- ✓ We will attempt to reduce the number of times we handle goods, materials, and arisings on site by careful selection of storage sites with regards to deliveries, use on site and removal of materials from site.
- ✓ When purchasing or organising the removal of waste we try to find the closest supplier/tip available to reduce transport load/miles.
- ✓ We will promote awareness of environmental responsibilities of our workforce and ensure they participate in the prevention of incidents and co-operate to prevent the release of harmful substances to the environment.
- ✓ Ensure regular maintenance of work equipment, mobile plant including road vehicles is carried out in line with manufacturers recommendations and the working environment.
- ✓ Direct delivery drivers and muck-away vehicles to minimise noise during unsociable hours, to be aware of their responsibilities regarding load security, to be considerate drivers and to comply with designated routing requirements.
- ✓ We will ensure that all relevant documentation produced takes account of The Environmental Protection Act 1990.
- ✓ We will ensure as far as reasonably practicable that any contractor used for the removal of waste is a registered carrier.
- ✓ Provide information, instruction and training on environmental matters relating to this policy to senior management and Site Supervisors to enable them to meet the standards.



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- ✓ Provide information, instruction and training to site operatives on environmental matters, in particular general environmental awareness training and site-specific inductions.
- ✓ Provide adequate resources to give competent advice on all aspects of the environment.
- ✓ Provide adequate resources to ensure full compliance with this policy, legislation and best practices.

This policy and associated procedures will be reviewed at least annually and revised as necessary to reflect changes in legislation and business activities.
